<b>SUMMARY AND PURPOSE OF REPORT</b>		
To present the latest draft of the Policing Plan for the year 2010-2013		
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	That members consider the latest draft of the Policing Plan 2010-13 at appendix 1.	

## **A. SUPPORTING INFORMATION**

### **1. BACKGROUND**

- 1.1 The requirement for the Police Authority to issue a Policing Plan is set out under section 6ZB of the Police Act 1996 (as inserted by the Police and Justice Act 2006) as outlined below.
- 1.2 Before the beginning of each financial year every police authority shall issue a policing plan setting out –
- The police authority's policing objectives for the policing of its area during that year; and
  - The proposed arrangements for the policing of that area for the period of three years beginning with that year (i.e. 2010 -13).
- 1.3 Policing objectives should be consistent with the strategic priorities determined by the Home Secretary under section 37A.
- 1.4 Before determining policing objectives, a police authority shall:
- a) consult the relevant chief officer of police; and
  - b) consider any views obtained by the authority in accordance with arrangements made under section 96 of the Police Act 1996.

## **2.0 POLICING PLAN 2010-13**

- 2.1 Members have considered a number of previous drafts of the Policing Plan. The latest draft is at appendix 1 to this report. This version reflects the Authority's recent budget decision for the coming year and final revisions to the Authority's strategic objectives.
- 2.2 Members will note there are several areas that are awaiting information. These are indicated by **red type**.
- 2.3 The Plan is presented for consideration of **content only** - the 'aesthetics' will be added at a later stage. These may be available for the meeting of the full Authority on 26 March 2010 when the Plan will be formally approved by the Authority.
- 2.4 Members are invited to consider the Policing Plan at appendix 1 prior to it being submitted to the Full Authority on 26 March 2010 for approval.
